

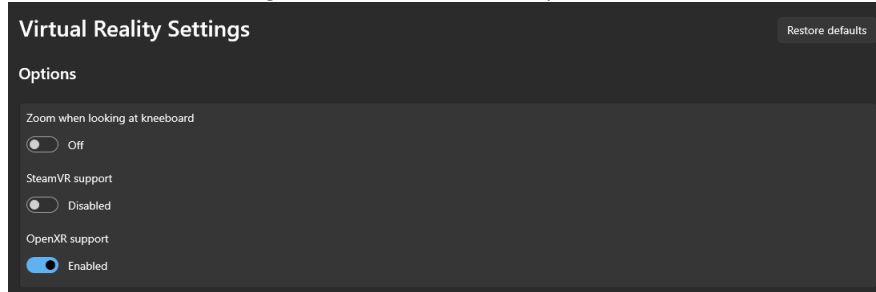
OpenXR iOverlay Setup Guide

Note: As far as I know you can only view one overlay, there may be a way to do multiple by experimenting with Tabs but I have not tried

Download [Openkneeboard](#) and install

In Openkneeboard, go to settings->Virtual Reality

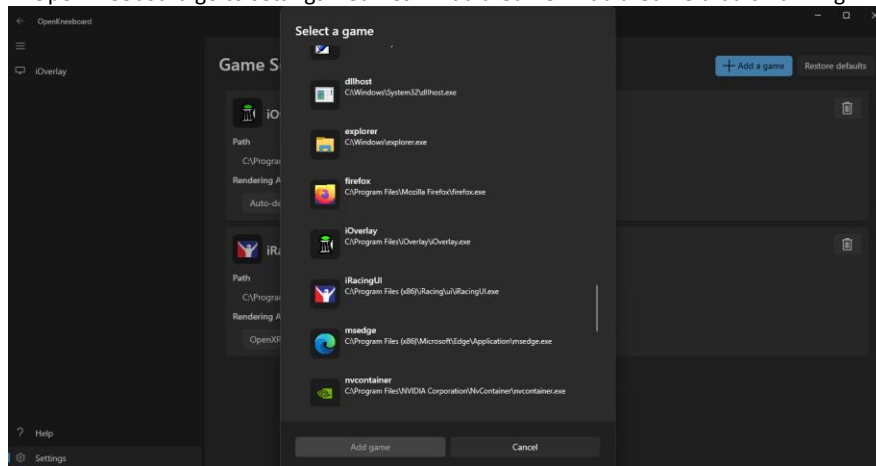
Disable Zoom when looking at kneeboard and enable OpenXR



Run iOverlay and start an iRacing session

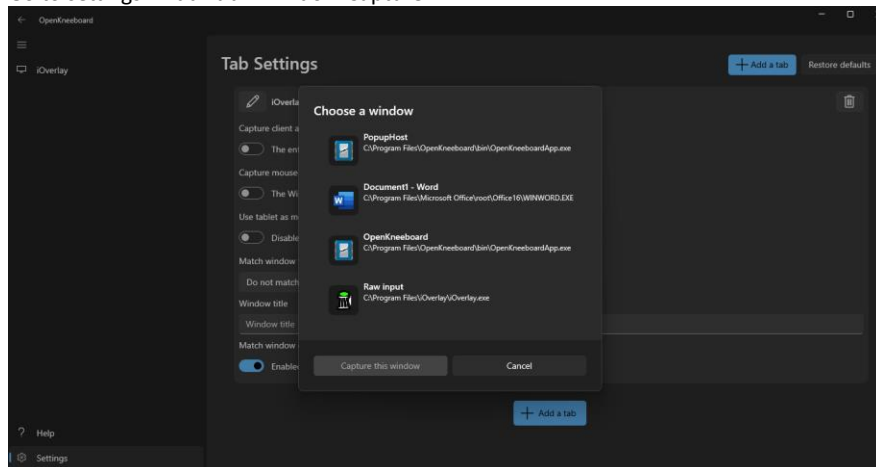
Choose your overlay and Enable Oculus VR Compatibility in iOverlay general settings and restart the program. You should see the overlay in a window on your desktop.

In Openkneeboard go to settings->Games-> Add a Game->Add a Game that is Running



Add iOverlay.exe and iRacingSim64DX11.exe (the actual game program not the iRacing UI)

Go to settings->Add Tab->Window Capture



Choose the iOverlay Raw input

Go to settings->Input

Bind the Recenter Kneeboard button to the same button you use to recenter your HMD

Put your headset on, recenter the HMD and look down, the overlay should be in your virtual lap

If you do not see an overlay, try restarting the iRacing session or Openkneeboard

Go back to settings->Virtual Reality adjust size and position of the overlay
